#### 17.31 MANAGEMENT OF BACK LANE WOODS AND PONDS

Councillor G Ormston informed the members that the Tree Condition survey had been completed and that a full report had been received which outlined a timetable of the proposed tree work which needed to be undertaken in the coming months. The work will be put out to tender and the resistograph work would be costed.

It was noted that one tree had been felled under Health and Safety.

**Woodland Management Proposals** 

The members discussed two proposals for the Management of Back lane woods.

The first proposal was to draw up a woodland management plan in house using a template from the woodland trust. Following on from this a schedule would be drawn up and execution of the work would be managed in-house.

The second proposal was to engage an organisation like Cuerden Valley Trust or the Wildlife Trust to draw up a management plan and execute the development of the woods for an annual fee.

It was agreed to table both proposals to the full parish council for consideration.
