#### 25.04 EXTERNAL AUDITORS REPORT

The smaller authority failed to approve the AGAR in time to publish it by 1 July 2025, the date required by the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 and did not disclose this by answering 'No' to Section 1, Box 1.

The Audit was completed late due to resourcing issues and a requirement to prioritise deadlines.

year's AGAR. The balance brought forward from the previous year of £72,980 (Section 2, Box 1) does not agree to the prior year balance carried forward of £112,285 (Section 2, Box 7) and no explanation was provided for difference.

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#### 25.05 BANK RECONCILIATION

#### 25.06 ACQUIRING ADDITIONAL ACCOUNTS
